You have been invited to take part in this study for my MSc dissertation in the Psychology of Advertising. Before you agree to participate, please take the time to read the following information carefully and decide whether or not you wish to take part.

What is the purpose of the study?

I am a Masters student (Psychology of Advertising) who is interested in researching LGBTQ+ portrayals in mainstream advertising, and consumer responses to such ads. Your participation in this study is completely voluntary.

What does the study entail?

The study comprises of one interview, within which you will be asked a series of questions regarding your views on prosocial advertising, specifically concerning LGBTQ+ depictions. You will also be shown three short adverts during the interview and questions will be asked about your attitudes towards the advertisements and the brands associated with them. This interview will last approximately 45 minutes and will be held over Microsoft Teams or in person where applicable. You will additionally be asked for some basic information about yourself, including your age, gender and LGBTQ+ community status; all of which are optional to answer. This information will allow us to report the general characteristics of our sample. The interview will be recorded, transcribed and anonymised for use in my dissertation report. The un-anonymised recording will be stored in a separate Lancaster University OneDrive folder in line with General Data Protection Regulation, which only the researcher and study supervisor will have access to. When the study is completed, all recordings will be deleted.

Confidentiality and Risks

Your participation in this study is entirely voluntary and confidential. You may choose to withdraw from the interview at any moment with no adverse consequences. If you wish to withdraw your data, you may contact myself or my project supervisor and there will be no adverse consequences. You will have 14 days to withdraw your data. Your answers may be used in my final report as quotes, however you will be given a pseudonym to ensure confidentiality is maintained. Additionally, any identifying information discussed in the interview will be left out of the written report to protect confidentiality. Furthermore, only the researcher and study supervisor will have access to the recording. If at any point you feel uncomfortable about anything which is raised within the interviews please remember that you do not need to answer any questions asked.
